Directions:

Step 1:

Blend, butter, sugar, spices, and salt. Beat egg yolks and add in. Sift in baking powder and flour, then add water and honey.

Step 2:

Put fruit and nuts through food processor until chopped and dust with flour to coat. Fold in stiffly beaten egg whites. Pour into a 13x9 inch pan/Bundt pan, and bake at 375 degrees F (190 degrees C) for one hour.

¼ Cup _____, Genesis 18:8

Garnish:

Sliced _____, Genesis 43:11

Directions:

In a 2-quart saucepan, over low heat, melt sugar, stirring occasionally to prevent sticking. After sugar melts, continue cooking, stirring continuously, until it is a deep golden brown. Add water and cook, stirring frequently until smooth.

Remove from heat, add butter and stir until it melts; allow to cool. Drizzle over cooled scripture cake and garnish with sliced almonds.
